## ☞ Mission Statement

The purpose of the PDD program is to provide the least restrictive environment to students who are considered to have communication impairment, pervasive developmental disorder, autism, and Asperger's Syndrome. Our program is designed to meet the specific needs of each child and in cooperation with the parents, provide a nurturing learning environment. We strive to meet each student's educational, social, and emotional needs in a structured and positive atmosphere.

## ☞ Holly Glen Elementary

The PDD program is a full day program located at Holly Glen Elementary School in the Monroe Township School District. An extended school year is available for children who are eligible. The student to staff ratio is 3-1. The maximum amount of students in each classroom is nine. Transportation is provided for all children involved in the program. The preschool hours are 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. The elementary classrooms follow the regular hours of the school building. The Holly Glen School provides education from Preschool to Fourth grade. The Kindergarten to fourth grade classrooms participate in special area instruction such as music, art, physical education and library.

## ☞ Behavior Management

The PDD program uses "best practices" in Applied Behavior Analysis, which is the use of behavior principles and methods to evaluate and systematically increase or decrease behavior in applied settings/real world day to day.

## ☞ Community Based Instruction

Community based instruction provides the opportunity for students to generalize skills across settings. This approach is beneficial to reinforce learned skills from inside the classroom. The program participates in community outings once a month. The classrooms attend age appropriate locations. Community outings provide opportunities for academic, social, functional and communicative skills in the community. The outings expose students to a variety of experiences to further the development of social, functional and communicative skills.
